Sunday Reflection - The greatest and most solemn Feast in the Church's Year has arrived. It is Easter Sunday "Rejoice, Christ is Risen, Alleluia". In our Liturgy during Lent we have 'fasted' from "Alleluias" for 40 days; flowers did not adorn the Altar, and our use of music was modest. Now that the great feast of Easter has arrived, we cannot contain our joy any longer. We celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. We burst forth with a chorus of "Alleluias" "Christ is Risen, Exult for Joy". "Exulted" is the name for the solemn Easter proclamation: "Rejoice, O Earth in shining splendor, radiant in the brightness of your king! Christ has conquered! Glory fills you! Darkness vanishes forever!" Choirs, orchestras, bands, and people cannot restrain their joy. This is the time for giving praise and thanks to God for raising Jesus from the dead. Jesus has emerged victorious from the tomb of death. The Resurrection of Jesus is God's defiant and final answer to a world that hoped death would hold Jesus in its grip forever. In the Resurrection God endorses everything Jesus lived for and taught, every value he treasured, and every word be proclaimed. His whole life is given new significance. In Christ we see God's plan for the whole of creation: Transfiguration and Resurrection. God, the creator of life, would not allow death to have the final word about Jesus. We rejoice because God's love is victorious over death and sin. The Father's love for Jesus sweeps death away as He reclaims his beloved Son. The Resurrection is God's protest against the finality of death. The love of the Father refuses to allow death to hold Jesus as its permanent victim. The Good News and reason for our rejoicing is that the Father's love manifested in Jesus' Resurrection, is extended to all who identify and follow 'The Way' of the beloved Son: "O truly blessed night, when things of heaven are wed to those of earth and the divine to the human". We are an Easter People and Alleluia is our Song!

Happy Easter – The Servite Friars and all who share in their community and ministry unite together in wishing everyone a very Happy and Blessed Easter. We want to thank you for all your support, generosity and great faith, which was so beautifully shared this Holy Week.

Easter Monday & Following: Monday $22^{\rm nd}$ April is a Public Holiday, so Mass will be at 10am only and the church will close after Mass. From Tuesday $23^{\rm rd}$ to Friday $26^{\rm th}$ April of this Easter Week there is only ONE Mass each day at 10am, No 6.30pm

St Peregrine Blessing – The 10am Mass on Wednesday 24th April will be the Mass of Easter Wednesday. We shall pray for healing for all who suffer from Cancer and other serious illnesses at that Mass and at the end of Mass we will have the usual veneration and prayers of Blessing with the Relic of St. Peregrine for all who request it. Let us continue to remember with love and faith all our brothers and sisters who need our prayers.

School Re-Opens – As most of the Easter holidays were before Easter this year, our Parish School re-opens on Tuesday 23rd April. We welcome Teachers, Staff and Pupils back for another term and pray God's Blessing on all our School Community.
