Sunday Reflection: -Holiday time approaches. Many look forward to a good break; they need time for rest, relaxation and solitude. In today's Gospel we find Jesus acknowledging this need for his Apostles - "you must come away to some lonely place and rest a while." In this we see the caring Jesus - Jesus is caring for the careers and trying to guard the value of rest and refreshment. But their escape into privacy does not succeed. The needy people foresee where they are aiming for and follow them. So, while holding the care of the apostles in his heart, Jesus is confronted with the large mass of people in desperate need before him. His solution to the dilemma is predictable; "he took pity on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd." He recognizes their need is greater. In this episode we meet the kind and tender Jesus. We see the kind of person Jesus is, and the kind of God Jesus reveals. We see the tenderness of God for his people. Jesus is the good shepherd, who commits himself to attending to the needs of the flock. What a contrast with the shepherd leaders criticized by the prophet Jeremiah? They abandon the sheep and neglect their basic duties of caring for the flock entrusted to them; "you have let my flock be scattered and go wandering and have not taken care of them". The good shepherd by contrast is prepared 'to put his life on the line' for the sake of the flock, because the sheep are always the Lord's sheep. Jesus shows us a compassionate and caring God, and he shows his Apostles and all of us that he wants to establish a compassionate caring Church, in touch with human needs and ready to reach out and respond to the needs that emerge from suffering and humanity.
